


# Music Haven 2022-2023 Impact Report

#### COMMUNITY:


We are focused on making sure every family is connected, supported, and included, from family check-ins, to help with transportation, support for basic needs, and potluck dinners.

#### **EQUITY:**


Our work as an arts organization is about pushing beyond access and equity to create a space of liberation for our students, their families, and everyone in our Music Haven community.

#### WELLNESS:


We are committed to wellness by prioritizing social time, incorporating meditation, yoga, and other physical activities, and centering emotional renewal. Music Haven had 91 students this year.

Our HERE ("Health & Emotional Recovery Education") to Play Initiative recognizes that our students deal with traumas and stresses that can significantly impact their physical and mental health. HERE to Play includes access to physical outlets within our programming day such as yoga, music therapy, meditation, martial arts, and dance.

# Academic Success

All of our students are presented with the opportunity to be tutored by excellent instructors. Students are tutored in subjects like math, reading, and science. Students who have gone through this program have seen great improvements in their respective subjects.
